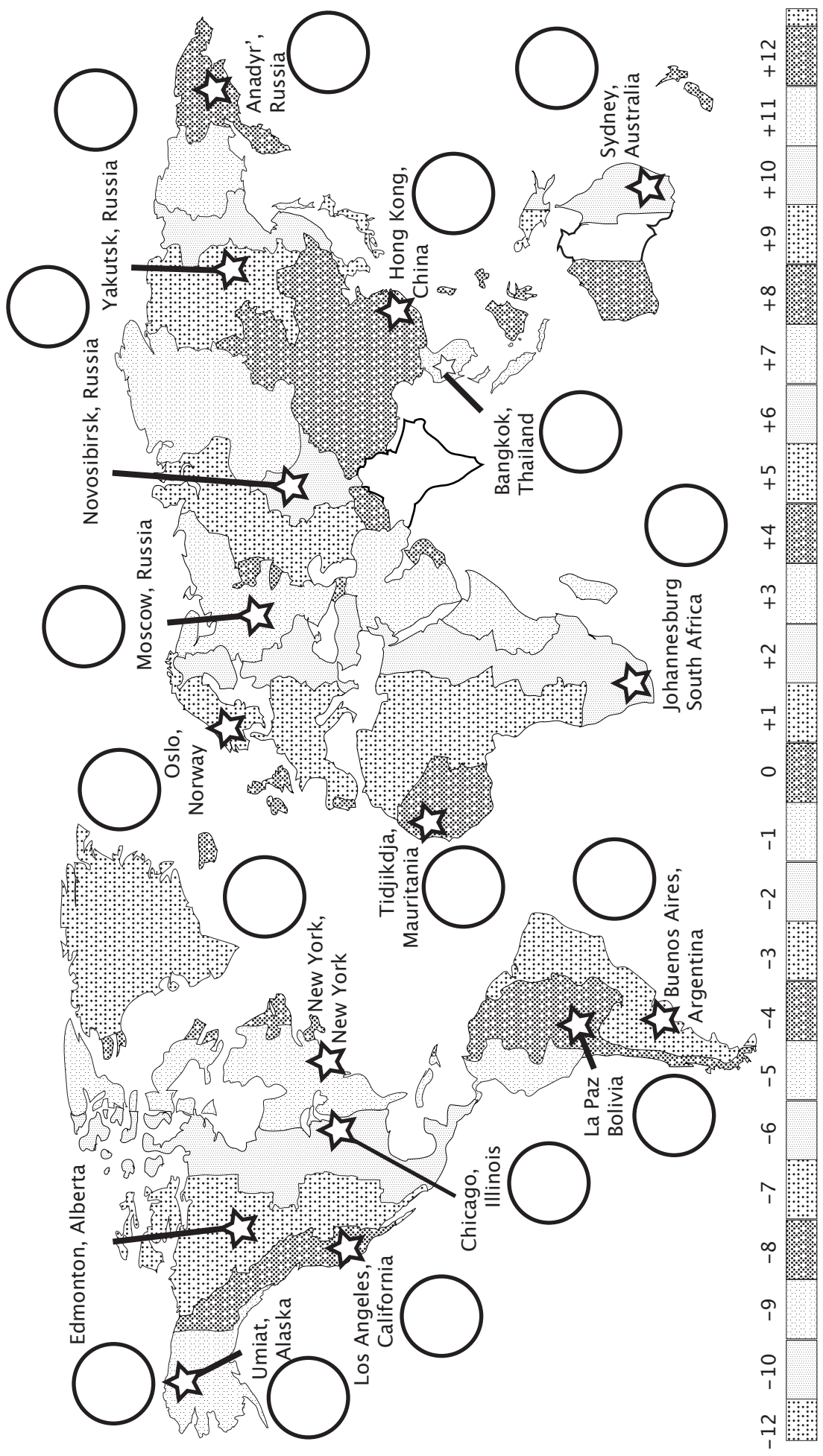


# MathFLIX CHALLENGE
